SENSORS - Two Mode PIR

The Solar street light fitted with a PIR (Passive Infrared Sensor) have Two Modes/settings available on the front of the sensor housing.

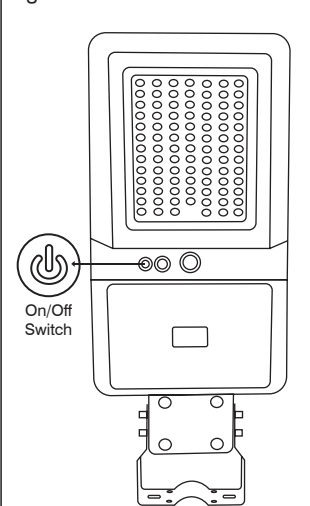
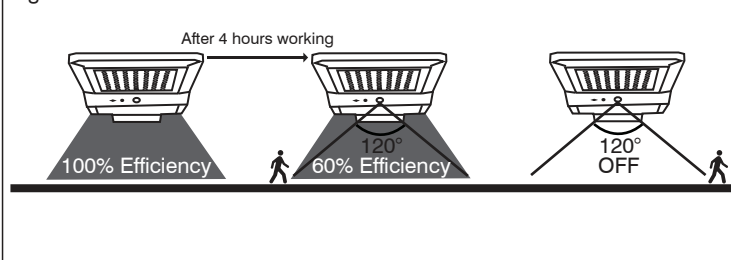


Fig 12. Please press the button on the lamp to filter through different modes.
Press once for Mode A.
Press twice time for Mode B.
Press three times for off.

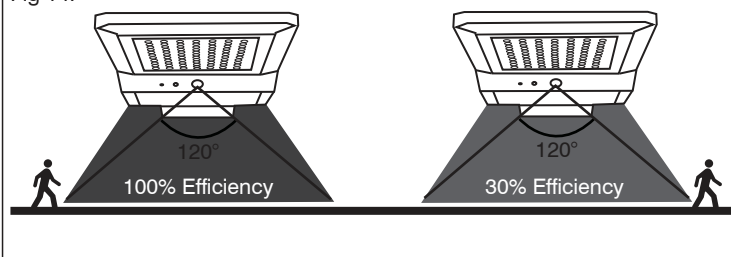

MODE: A - Constant Light

Fig 13. Press On/Off button once or use the remote control and fitting will automatically turn on at night. Maintaining 60% efficiency constantly for 4 hours, switching to Sensor Mode.

MODE: B - Sensor Mode

Fig 14. Press On/Off button twice or use the remote control and fitting will automatically turn on at 100%, full efficiency when motion is detected in the range ≤12mtrs. Switching to 30% efficiency after 20 seconds of no motion.

1. Above modes are default settings. Alternative settings can be added through the remote control. Settings made from the remote control override MODE A & MODE B made using the fitting and visa versa.
2. Mode A & B cannot both be set to Constant or Sensor Mode at the same time.
3. After fittings gets a restart, it will continue to function in the last working mode.

Remote control distance ≤12m - For unlimited fittings in that radius

The fitting will flash once each time a button is pressed, indicating each setting is set successfully.

USING REMOTE CONTROL:



Mode: A - Constant Lighting

- Time and brightness are both adjustable (Fig 15.)
1. Press button "Constant Lighting Mode";
2. Press button "Time 2H".
3. Press button "Brightness 60%", **Example:**
At night, fitting automatically turns on at 60% efficiency for 2hrs, then switching to Sensor Mode.

Mode: B - Sensor Mode

(Fig 15.)
1. Press button "Sensor Mode";
2. Press button "Brightness 60%", **Example:**
Fitting automatically turns on at 60% efficiency when motion is detected in the ≤12mtrs range. Switching to 20% efficiency after 20 seconds of no motion.

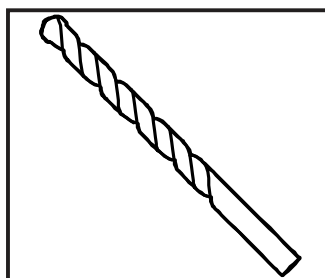

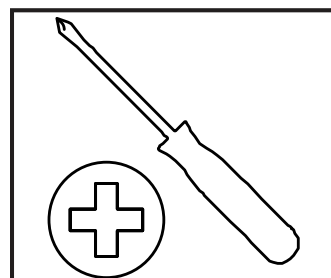

INSTALLATION A- Straight Pole

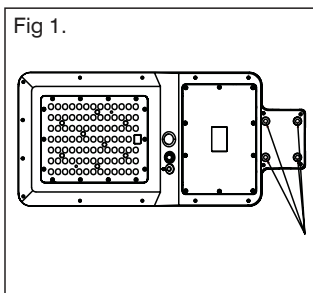


Fig 1. Make sure the 4 bottom screws are tightened.

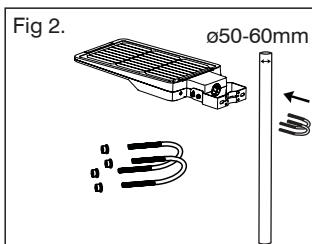


Fig 2. Remove bolts from U-brackets, insert U-bracket through the pole then into the lamp bracket

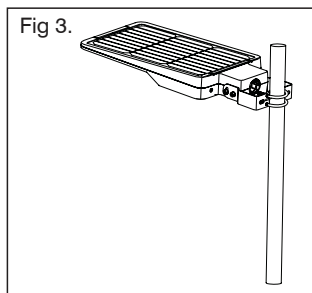


Fig 3. Tighten screws to fix lamp onto the pole (size ø50-60mm).

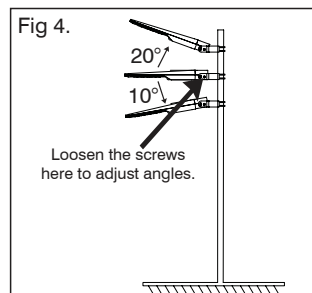


Fig 4. Loosen screws and adjust angle position as needed.

INSTALLATION B- Curved Pole

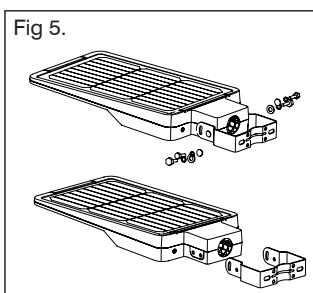


Fig 5. Loosen the screws and remove the U-shaped bracket

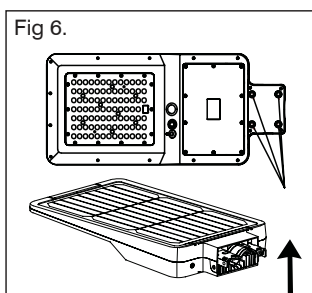


Fig 6. Loosen all four screws enough to fit pole

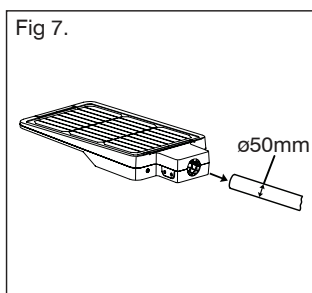


Fig 7. Screw fitting onto the pole (size ø50mm).

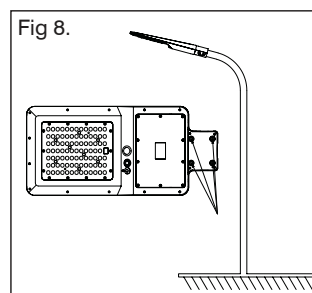


Fig 8. Adjust & balance, secure the fitting by tightening all four screws

INSTALLATION C- Wall Mount

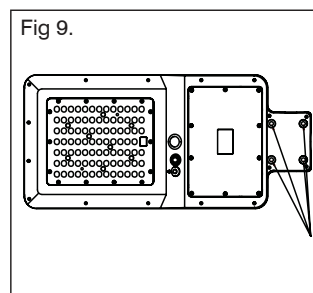


Fig 9. First, make sure the 4 bottom screws are tightened.

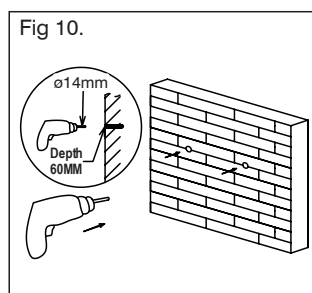


Fig 10. Drill 2 holes, ø14mm, depth 60mm, 104mm apart.

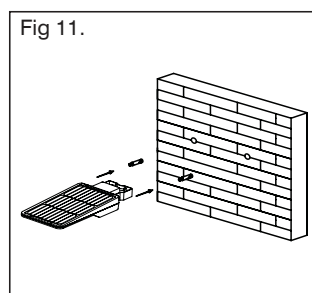


Fig 11. Use 2 Rawl plugs and 2 screws, fix the lamp on the wall.

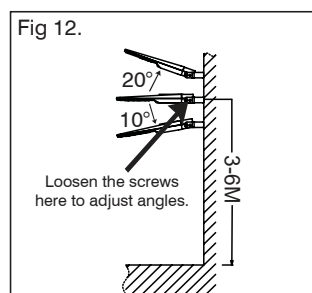


Fig 12. Loosen screws and adjust angle position as needed.
